As a part of IStructE Centenary activity, North Thames Branch is arranging a photography competition, which is open to all of members of the institution.

Members are invited to submit digital pictures of structures that he/she finds interesting, evocative or remarkable in relation to structural engineering and built environment to NTBPhotoCompetition@istructe.org



Examples of subjects could be a mud hut in Africa, a historical building in Iran, a temple in China, a bridge, a stadium, a barn in Shropshire, etc. Each picture should be identified by its location, the photographer, type and name. A brief text of maximum fifty words describing its uniqueness and outstanding features should be provided.

The deadline for submission of entries is 15th September 2008. All pictures should be submitted in digital jpeg format no larger than 1MB.

A panel comprising members of the North Thames Branch Committee will convene to judge the entries. The winners will be announced in early October 2008.

The best picture will receive £200, with the two runners up getting each £50 at the NTB annual general meeting in mid October 2008.

Rules

1. The competition will be administered by the North Thames Branch (NTB) of the Institution of Structural Engineers.
2. The theme of the competition has been given in the aforementioned information.
3. All entries will be acknowledged.

4. Competition entries shall be the entrant's own work and shall be forwarded to the North Thames Branch no later than 15/09/08.
5. The entries shall be submitted by e-mail to the following address:

6. Each entry shall clearly show the entrant's details, including name, membership number and contact details.
7. The competition is open to all student, graduate, technician, associate and chartered member of the Institution of Structural Engineers.
8. The size of the photograph shall not be more than 1 Mb.
9. The copyright in the entry shall remain the entrant's but the NTB reserve the right to copy, display, and generally use for publicity and promotional purposes in their sole discretion any or all of the entries thereof.
10. The results of the competition will be announced in early October 2008. Prizes will be awarded at the NTB Annual General Meeting in mid-October 2008.
11. The judges' decision will be final without appeal. No correspondence will be entered into with entrants concerning their decision.
12. The best picture will receive £200, with the two runners-up each getting £50 together with certificates of distinction.
13. The judges reserve the right not to make any award if in their opinion there are no entries of requisite merit.
14. The judges will give equal weight to creativity, originality, evocativeness, outstanding features and topicality of entries.
