Guide to preparing Branch/Division issues of ***The Structural Engineer***

Issues of *The Structural Engineer* generally contain

1) 2 formal papers, each of not more than 4000 words, with 5 or 6 illustrations each. Branches normally review their papers before submitting them, after which they are reviewed, normally by a member of the Editorial Advisory Group, for the Journal (required 3 clear months before date of publication to allow time for our vetting procedure).

2) Other material can include a technical note of 2000-3000 words and/or a viewpoint, project or other article of 1000- 2000 words (required 2 clear months before publication). Other possibilities e.g. an interview, should be decided in conjunction with the editor who is happy to assist in writing them. (see features guide for further information)

3) Structural News items —short reports and photos on branch activities etc. can be included as appropriate, but these will be slotted into the general news. (arrange with the editor)

Advertising

Branches are not expected to supply advertising, but we do need contacts for possible advertising, for example, local companies with whom branches are involved, or who might be prepared to support a paper or feature, or pay for the front cover illustrating branch work.
