tl; dr We are celebrating the Region's talent and open our structural awards to all. Entrants must complete a PowerPoint template which will be shown at an Award Presentation in 2026 when the winners will be announced.

Entry Guidelines

The Awards are **FREE TO ENTER**

The Awards will be judged on the structural engineering content of the application.

Submissions are invited from all organisations of any size and entries are particularly encouraged from small practices, specialist firms and sole practitioners.

The structural design must have been predominantly carried out by a member of the Institution in the Region of **any** grade.

All projects must have been substantially completed in the 2025 calendar year.

All eligible entries will be shown during a presentation to celebrate the awards and likely at the event to inaugurate the new Chair of the South East Regional Group **in Early 2026**.

Winners will be announced during the presentation and winning projects and those receiving commendations will receive certificates directly from the Institution. Images of the award winners and project details may be used to promote structural engineering in the Region.

Categories

To remove some worries about entry, we have removed the need to assign a category.

We will assign categories at the committee's discretion. If in doubt, submit it 😊

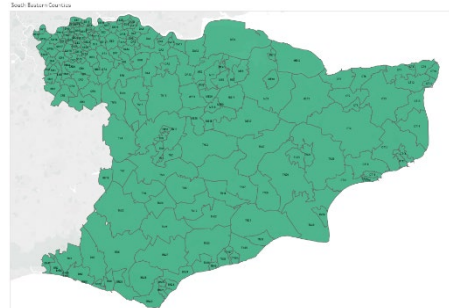

Project Award Judging

Entries will be judged on submitted information only and will be judged based on the criteria provided in the entry requirements below.

Judging will be by the South East Regional Group Committee or their delegates. All categories will be awarded at the judges' discretion. The judges' decision is final.



Project Awards Entry Requirements

Entries must be submitted using the provided PowerPoint slide template. For consistency try not to tinker with the first slide layout too much. Otherwise, use space provided for as many images as you feel would be legible on a projector and which demonstrate the key structural aspects of the project. Less is more when it comes to text!

Up to two additional slides may be included with the main presentation slide if more space is required.

Our priority is to reduce the entry requirements to a level where practices of whatever size, feel able to enter a project. We do not want the amount of time required to produce an entry to put members off.

Terms & Conditions

- The award entry must have a structural emphasis.
- All entries must have been substantially completed in the calendar year of 2025.
- The South East Regional Group is formed of the following Hubs: South Eastern Counties, Southern, Surrey, Thames Valley
- The structural design must have been predominantly carried out by a member of the Institution in the Region of any grade. For clarity, a project qualifies for our 2025 awards if one of the following applies:
 - The project is located in the South East Regional Group
 - The designing company office is located within the South East Regional Group
 - The engineer on the project is a member of the South East Regional Group. i.e. you get the emails from us
- **If in doubt, submit it anyway, we're here to celebrate everything we do!**
- All members of the project team, including the client shall have given consent for the project to be entered into the Awards.
- If phases of the submitted design have been carried out by different organisations, the engineer submitting the entry must have obtained the agreement of the other parties involved. If necessary, a joint entry may be submitted.
- Permission should be obtained from the photographer or other copyright owner to use the photographs or other media submitted as part of your application. If copyright of any images belongs to another party, then this must be clearly stated in your submission. There is a space for this on the slide template.
- By submitting an entry, you consent to the use of all submitted media by The Institution of Structural Engineers and the Regional Group and Hubs in any of its communications and for other promotional material. This may include, but is not limited to print and digital marketing, PR and exhibition purpose.
- For clarity the Regional Group boundaries are shown on the following page.
- **We repeat - if you feel you miss some of the criteria, do not worry, send us your entry with an email explaining. This is a celebration of our work.**
