Preparation Course for the Chartered Membership Examination of The Institution of Structural Engineers

A part-time evening course to prepare candidates for the CM examination of The Institution of Structural Engineers is to be held in the North Thames Regional Group area starting 20 February 2019. The numbers are limited to 36 places to allow a free exchange of questions to the presenters.

Details are as follows:

Subject areas covered: The emphasis will be on conceptual solutions to past CM examination questions, examination time management and presentation, covering:

- Analysis
- Reports

The CM examinations questions treated in this course will relate principally to the design of building-type structures, including their foundations. Structures of a special nature, such as silos, bunkers, chimneys, off-shore platforms, road/rail bridges and seismic structures will not be considered.
