On Tuesday 9th October 2018, Pat Ruddock and Tom Martin of Mann Williams Cardiff Office will present an evening lecture on the refurbishment of the Four Elms building on Four Elms Road, Cardiff.

The building was originally part of the Trinity Methodist Church on Four Elms, but became derelict and is now the new head quarters of the “NoFit State Community Circus”

The structural scheme centres on increasing head-room for circus training and providing a purpose-built rig for performers and community alike.

The project has been shortlisted for the IStructE Regional Groups Award, which focuses on projects that have a demonstrable benefit to the community.

The Lecture is at 6.15pm in the Trevithick Lecture Theatre, which is located on the 2nd Floor of the Trevithick Building, Cardiff University, CF24 3AA.
