Notice is hereby given

1. To read the notice convening the meeting.
2. To read, confirm and sign the minutes of the General Meeting held on 10 July 2025.
3. To receive the financial statements and balance sheet for the year 2025, together with the auditors' report thereon, and the report of the Trustee Board for 2025.
4. To appoint auditors for the ensuing year and to fix their remuneration. (The Board recommends HaysMac LLP chartered accountants and registered auditors, at a fee to be agreed with them by the Board).
5. To consider and, if thought fit, to adopt the following motion:

THAT, in accordance with the provisions of Regulation 3.1, and in confirmation of proposals of the Board, annual subscriptions with effect from 1 January 2027, and until otherwise determined, shall be:

The annual subscriptions for 2027 represent a 3.5% increase on the subscription rates for 2026.

Explanatory Note 1 – Standing Order 5.1 defines a ‘meeting’ as in addition to a physical assembly of members of a body, a meeting shall include the organised interaction of its members by means of telephone or audio conferencing or by electronic means, or by means of any other form of technology whether in existence at the coming into effect of these standing orders or not.

Explanatory Note 2 – Regulation 5.7.1 defines ‘Voting Member’ as every Chartered Structural Engineer, Associate, Incorporated Structural Engineer, Technician-Member and Graduate whose subscription, and every other sum which shall be due and payable to the Institution in respect of their membership, has been paid.

Explanatory Note 5 – In accordance with Regulation 5.3, only the business specified in this notice may be considered at the meeting.

Explanatory Note 6 – The rates of subscription paid by retired members are set by the Board under Regulation 3.5. The rates for 2027 will be: Retired Fellow with The Structural Engineer £109; Retired other grades with The Structural Engineer £90, Retired without The Structural Engineer £48.
